- ★ Compose 3 different pieces through the draft stage of the Writing Process of at least 1 ½ to 2 pages in length using typing guidelines.
- ★ Select one of the drafts above to publish, using the STEM Rubric. Show editing on drafts that you went through the entire writing process. Follow rubric and be at least 1 ½ to 2 pages in length using the typing guidelines.

For a student to earn an A level they must:

- ★ Compose 3 different pieces through the draft stage of the Writing Process of at least 2 ½ to 4 pages in length using typing guidelines.
- ★ Select one of the drafts above to publish, using the STEM Rubric. Show editing on drafts that you went through the entire writing process. Follow rubric and be at least 2 ½ to 4 pages in length using the typing guidelines.
