For a student to earn a C level they must:

- ★Complete Notice & Note final project

For a student to earn a B level they must:

- ★ Compose a choice piece of at least 1 ½ to 2 pages in length using typing guidelines and following the rubric.
- ★ Present choice piece to class
- ★Complete Reflections in Online Portfolio
- ★Complete Notice & Note final project

For a student to earn an A level they must:

- ★ Compose a choice piece of at least 2 ½ to 4 pages in length using typing guidelines and following the rubric.
- ★ Present choice piece to class
- ★Complete Reflections in Online Portfolio
- ★Complete Notice & Note final project

- Complete all daily work, planner checks, and other assignments
- Complete grammar lessons on Quill
- Participate appropriately in class during editing groups and work time
